## **Minutes for Local 696 General Membership**

### **Meeting**

#### **Call To Order:**

A General Membership Meeting of Local 696 was held on September 16, 2023, at 6:15pm in person, and was presided over by President Anthony Dinkins with Tori Rodgers as secretary.

#### **Attendees**

Members from the local signed a sign-in-sheet.

#### **Suspension of the rules**

A motion to suspend the rules was presented by President Anthony Dinkins, motion was made by Nathaniel Brown and seconded by Fatina El. Motion carried.

#### **Officer Reports/ Agenda**

President Ernest Garrett addressed the membership and spoke on the local coming together in light of the three consecutive elections the local had been in. He said that elections were not cheap and that the local should soldier on and not fight amongst each other. He said that our focus should be on fighting the city when the time came.

President Ernest Garrett then administered the oath of office to the officers and stewards of local 696.

Secretary of Local 696, Tori Rodgers, presented the plaque, given to her by the AFL-CIO because District Council 33 won the third highest representation in the Labor Day Parade, to President Ernest Garrett. After the presentation President Ernest Garrett said that there is no reason why we couldn't win first place since it was only a two hour parade.

President Ernest Garrett said that there were many options for the members to keep them from being on the sick abuse list. If a member did not have a doctor at 30th street they still can obtain sick notes because they are members of District Council 33. There is also a Teledoc option for members to take part in.

#### **Main Motions**

President Anthony Dinkins moved for a motion to approve the minutes. Fatina El 1st Abileka Boyd 2nd .Motion Carried. President Anthony Dinkins asked for a motion to approve the financial report. President Emeritus Bobby Davis 1st Joycia Davis 2nd. Motion Carried.

#### **Old/New Business**

President Dinkins said that President Garrett was correct when he said that we shouldn't be fighting one another but City Hall. President Dinkins introduced our lawyer Will Bravemann who then addressed the membership.

President Dinkins then said that we are not battling but want to move forward in positivity

and want to get back to being focused on helping the members and keeping the legacy of the organization intact.

The head of the election committee Darlene Booker- Jones was called on to present the election report to the members. After her presentation both President Dinkins and President Emeritus Davis spoke on the integrity of the election committee.

It was revealed that there was a three way tie with the members of the Rabble Rousers for a steward-delegate spot which would necessitate a runoff election for the spot.

There was a motion made to come back in person to 30th street to vote rather than via the mail-in ballots. Fatina El 1st Joycia 2nd. The membership unanimously agreed. Motion Carried.

President Dinkins said that he would see if the Rabble Rousers would select a candidate or if there would indeed be an election.

President Dinkins spoke on how the meetings during the height of the pandemic were carried on over zoom to keep everyone safe. That is also why the method of the mail-in ballots were chosen for everyone's safety. Now the general membership meetings are conducted in person and while some members would like zoom meetings we don't know who is potentially listening in, so we won't be using that method anymore.

Mary Kachline told the membership about the Autism Ball being held in December to raise funds for interactive equipment at the library.

President Dinkins called for a motion to adjourn. Fatina El 1st and Aurellia Harrell 2nd. Motion Carried at 730pm.
